Dear Patron:

In an effort to execute an efficient and timely show, please give this sheet to the primary contact who will be present at the location where the performance will take place.

**A. PLEASE PROVIDE:**

- (1) One (1) contact person to meet Christina Dzenyuy upon her arrival (approximately 45 minutes before a school performance and 1 hour before a theatre performance), to show Ms. Dzenyuy to the performance area, help load and unload equipment before and after performances and to run the sound and lights during the performance(s).
- (2) In-door Lighting (if applicable): If on a stage, general stage lighting is required. Lighting technician to run lights during the show. If in another space, i.e. cafeteria, gymnasium, full house lighting will be used. Ms. Dzenyuy will work with the lighting at your facility.
- (3) Sound: **WE WILL BRING** - One (1) Airline Micro Wireless UHF Earset System.  
**WE WILL NEED** - Front-of-House Speakers for audience, on-stage monitor for talent, sound engineer to run sound during the show, ¼ inch line connection for key board, ¼ inch line (or mic) connection for our wireless earset system (line input preferable), one (1) dvd player to play one instrumental song track during show.
- (4) An electrical outlet.
- (5) A clean stage.
- (6) Seven folding chairs and 6-8 bottled waters.
- (7) One room, unlocked, close to the stage set aside as a dressing room.
- (8) Access to a bathroom, close to the stage.

**B. YOU SHOULD KNOW:**

- (1) Christina Dzenyuy will arrive approximately 45 minutes before a school show, and 1 hour before public performances.
- (2) The performance lasts approximately 60 minutes.
- (3) For optimum enjoyment of the performance:
  - a. Bells and buzzers should be shut off in auditoriums during the performance.
  - b. Shades on auditorium windows should be drawn and doors shut during performances.
- (4) Video- or Sound-recording of the show is not allowed.
